Theme Scripture

Romans 12:21 (KJV)

“Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.”

Key Precepts

- **Matthew 5:14–16** – “*Ye are the light of the world... let your light so shine before men...*”
 - **Proverbs 25:21–22** – “*If thine enemy be hungry, give him bread to eat...*”
 - **Ephesians 5:11** – “*Have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.*”
 - **Romans 12:17–18** – “*Recompense to no man evil for evil...*”
 - **1 Peter 2:15** – “*For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men.*”

Lesson Points

1. Darkness only wins if we copy it

Evil spreads when we **respond with evil**, hatred, or fleshly reactions. But Yah commanded us to overcome evil — not with fire, but with **faithfulness**.

“A soft answer turneth away wrath...” — Proverbs 15:1

2. Your light is your weapon

- Your example is your power.
- Your obedience is your warfare.
- When you shine, it **exposes** wickedness and **leads others out of it**.

“Let your light so shine...” — Matthew 5:16

3. Mercy disarms the wicked

“If your enemy is hungry, feed him...” — Proverbs 25:21

This doesn't make you weak — it makes you like the Most High, who is merciful and slow to anger.
