# **P** Lesson Points

### 1. Darkness only wins if we copy it

Evil spreads when we **respond with evil**, hatred, or fleshly reactions. But Yah commanded us to overcome evil — not with fire, but with faithfulness.

"A soft answer turneth away wrath..." — Proverbs 15:1

### 2. Your light is your weapon

- Your example is your power.
- Your obedience is your warfare.
- When you shine, it exposes wickedness and leads others out of it.

#### 3. Mercy disarms the wicked

"If your enemy is hungry, feed him..." — Proverbs 25:21 This doesn't make you weak — it makes you like the Most High, who is merciful and slow to anger.

- O Do one act of mercy this week to someone who doesn't deserve it
- Refuse to clap back fight with calm, Scripture, and patience
- Pray for your enemies not so they win, but so they wake up
