Theme Scripture

Genesis 3:15 (KJV):

"And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel."

I. The Nature of the Serpent's Seed

John 8:44

"Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do..."

Ephesians 2:1-3

Describes mankind in his natural, sinful state as being under the power of "the prince of the power of the air," walking in disobedience.

Psalm 51:5

"Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me."

- All unconverted mankind walks in sin.
- Sin makes one a servant of Satan (Romans 6:16).
- Thus, all are spiritually the seed of the serpent until they are born again.

II. The Call to Conversion

Acts 3:19

"Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out..."

Romans 8:9

"Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his."

1 Peter 1:23

"Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God..."

- Conversion is necessary to transition from the seed of the serpent to the seed of God.
- One must repent, obey, and receive the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38).

III. Manifesting Who You Belong To

1 John 3:10

"In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God..."

Matthew 13:38

"The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one."

- Righteousness (obedience to God's commandments) proves who you belong to.
- Disobedience exposes those who are still of the serpent.

IV. The Battle and the Victory

Revelation 12:17

"And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed..."

Revelation 14:12

"Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus."

- There is enmity (hostility) between the serpent's seed and the woman's seed.
- Victory belongs to those who keep Yah's commandments and have faith in the Messiah.

Conclusion: Who Do You Belong To?

Until one is converted, they are counted among the seed of the serpent. But the Word offers the power to become the sons of God (John 1:12). Let us examine ourselves to see if we have been born again through obedience and faith in Messiah. Let us not merely claim righteousness with our lips, but demonstrate it through our actions.

Righteousness: The Children of God Are Known by Obedience"

Objective

To prove by Scripture that righteousness is obedience to God's laws, statutes, commandments, and judgments — and that only those who obey are counted as the children of God.

I. What Is Righteousness?

Deuteronomy 6:25

"And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as he hath commanded us."

- Righteousness is not a feeling it is obedience.
- This is the biblical definition.

Psalm 119:172

"My tongue shall speak of thy word: for all thy commandments are righteousness."

• The commandments are righteousness — not separate from it.

📒 II. Righteousness Is Action, Not Claim

1 John 3:7

"Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous."

• Don't be deceived — only those who **do** righteousness are righteous.

Ezekiel 18:9

"Hath walked in my statutes, and hath kept my judgments, to deal truly; he is just, he shall surely live, saith the Lord God."

- A righteous man walks in obedience.
- This is the path to life, not just belief alone.

📒 III. Children of God vs. Children of the Devil

1 John 3:10

"In this the children of God are manifest..."

- If you do not obey, you are not of God clear distinction.
- Manifest" = revealed by your behavior.

1 John 3:4

"Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law."

• If righteousness is obedience, then sin is law-breaking.

E IV. Obedience Is the Fruit of Love

John 14:15

"If ye love me, keep my commandments."

• There is **no separation** between love and obedience.

V. Warning to the Disobedient

Titus 1:16

"They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient..."

• Claiming to know God means nothing if you are disobedient.

Discussion Prompt (Optional)

"How do modern churches define righteousness, and how does it compare to what we've read in Scripture?"

Call to Action

Examine yourself:

- Are you obeying His laws?
- Are you walking in righteousness?
- Or do you only profess Him with your mouth?

1 Closing Verse

Revelation 22:14

"Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life..."

Lesson Title: You Shall Know Them by Their Fruit

Theme Scripture

Matthew 7:16-20 (KJV)

"Ye shall know them by their fruits... Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them."

LESSON PURPOSE

To teach how to discern between true believers and false teachers by examining their obedience to Yah's commandments. Fruit in Scripture is not emotions or crowds, but **obedient works of righteousness**.

What Is the Fruit?

Galatians 5:22-23 (KJV)

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance..."

Psalm 119:172 (KJV)

"...for all thy commandments are righteousness."

True fruit is behavior, character, and commandment-keeping. Those who claim Christ but disobey Yah are bearing bad fruit.

1 John 2:4 (KJV)

*"He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar..."

Warning: False Prophets Look Righteous

Matthew 7:15 (KJV)

*"Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing..."

They will use the name of Christ:

Matthew 7:22-23 (KJV)

"Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord... and then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

Iniquity = lawlessness = breaking commandments



Test of a True Teacher

- 1. Do they teach obedience to Torah? (Deut. 13:1-5)
- 2. Do they deny or nullify commandments? (Isa. 8:20)
- 3. Do their lives show righteousness or worldliness? (1 John 3:7-8)
- 4. Do they bear the fruit of the Spirit AND obedience? (Gal. 5 + Rev. 14:12)



Call to Action

2 Corinthians 13:5 (KJV)

*"Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith..."

Don't be deceived by smooth words. Compare all teachers to the Word. Follow only those who do righteousness.



Final Charge

Revelation 14:12 (KJV)

"Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus."

Title: Manifestation of the Serpent's Seed Through Deception and Whitewashing History

Theme Scripture John 8:44 (KJV)

"Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth... for he is a liar, and the father of it."

I. What Is Whitewashing?

- Whitewashing is the act of covering up or altering truth to serve a false narrative.
- When applied to history, it is used to erase the identity, accomplishments, and suffering of oppressed peoples—especially the true children of Israel.
- According to the Scriptures, deception is not neutral—it is demonic.

Revelation 21:8 – "...and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

II. Deceptive Nations and Empires: Manifesting the Seed of the Serpent

1. Rome (Pagan and Papal)

- Daniel 7:25 "He shall... think to change times and laws..."
- Changed Sabbath to Sunday, feasts to holidays, and repainted the Messiah in their own image.
- Central to spreading the trinity doctrine and erasing the commandments.

2. Babylon – The Mother of Abominations

- **Revelation 17:5** "Mystery, Babylon the Great, the Mother of Harlots..."
- The religious and economic deception that began with Nimrod lives on in systems that dominate the world.

3. European Colonial Powers

- **Obadiah 1:4** "Though thou exalt thyself as the eagle..."
- Britain, Spain, France, Portugal, the Netherlands:
 - o Enslaved millions.
 - o Imposed false Christianity.
 - o Rewrote history to depict Africans as cursed and themselves as chosen.
 - o Repainted biblical figures to look European.

4. United States (Daughter of Babylon)

- **Jeremiah 50:33** "The children of Israel and the children of Judah were oppressed together..."
- Promoted a false gospel of lawlessness.
- Institutionalized racism while professing godliness.
- Exported false Christianity to the nations.
- Commercialized the name of Jesus and erased the true identity of His people.

III. Scriptural Judgment for Deception

Isaiah 5:20 – "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil..."

Ezekiel 22:26 – "Her priests have violated my law... and I am profaned among them."

Revelation 18:4-5 – "Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins..."

IV. The True Path to Righteousness

1 John 3:10 – "In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God..."

Ecclesiastes 12:13 – "Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man."

- Systems and nations that build their power on lies and whitewashing are not of God.
- To continue in these systems without repentance is to remain in the serpent's seed.

Call to Action

- Teach your children the true heritage of the people of YAH.
- Come out of Babylon and walk in righteousness.

- Those who uphold false doctrines and deny God's law perpetuate satanic lies.

3. Power

Isaiah 14:13–14 – "I will ascend into heaven... I will be like the most High."

- The devil lusts for godlike authority.
- His seed seek global control: surveillance states, economic tyranny, and antichrist agendas.

Luke 4:6 – "All this power will I give thee... if thou therefore wilt worship me."

4. Worship
