False Anointing, Political Idolatry, and the Deception of the Last Days

THE WORD OF YAH THROUGH THE PROPHETS

Throughout Scripture, whenever corruption spreads and leaders refuse correction, Elohim raises up prophets to warn the people.

The prophet is not raised up because the people are righteous.

The prophet is raised up because the people have become rebellious.

The Prophet as Elohim's Warning

Amos 3:7 (KJV)

“Surely YAH ELOHIM will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.”

Before judgment falls, Elohim sends warning.

Before destruction comes, Elohim speaks.

But when people reject that warning, judgment follows.

PROPHETS CONFRONT CORRUPT POWER

The prophets did not remain silent before rulers.

They confronted sin openly.

Elijah Rebuked the King

1 Kings 18:17–18 (KJV)

“And it came to pass, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said unto him, Art thou he that troubleth Israel?

And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house...”

The king blamed the prophet.

But Elijah declared the truth:

The trouble was the king's sin.

Jeremiah Rebuked a Corrupt Nation

Jeremiah 5:26–28 (KJV)

“For among my people are found wicked men...
They judge not the cause, the cause of the fatherless...”

Jeremiah described a society where:

- the wicked prospered
 - justice disappeared
 - the innocent were ignored
-

John the Baptist Rebuked a Ruler

Luke 3:19 (KJV)

“But Herod the tetrarch, being reproved by him... for all the evils which Herod had done.”

John rebuked a ruler publicly.

He did not soften the message.

For that rebuke, he was imprisoned and eventually killed.

Messiah Rebuked Religious Hypocrisy

Matthew 23:33 (KJV)

“Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?”

Messiah rebuked religious leaders who:

- protected corruption
 - oppressed the people
 - used religion to maintain power
-

THE PATTERN OF FALSE ANOINTING

One of the greatest deceptions among Elohim’s people has always been this:

When a ruler gains power, many begin to call that ruler **Elohim’s anointed**, even when his actions contradict the commandments of Elohim.

Scripture shows this pattern repeatedly.

Saul — Anointed but Rejected

1 Samuel 10:1 (KJV)

“Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured it upon his head... and said, Is it not because YAH hath anointed thee to be captain over his inheritance?”

Saul was truly anointed.

But anointing does not guarantee obedience.

1 Samuel 15:23 (KJV)

“Because thou hast rejected the word of YAH, he hath also rejected thee from being king.”

Elohim removed Saul.

Yet many people continued to follow him.

The lesson is clear:

Anointing does not give a man permanent authority if he rebels against Elohim.

Ahab — Wicked Power With Religious Support

1 Kings 16:30 (KJV)

“And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of YAH above all that were before him.”

Yet Ahab had hundreds of prophets supporting him.

1 Kings 22:6 (KJV)

“Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men...”

These prophets told the king exactly what he wanted to hear.

They protected power instead of speaking for Elohim.

But one prophet spoke the truth.

1 Kings 22:8 (KJV)

“There is yet one man... but I hate him; for he doth not prophesy good concerning me, but evil.”

The king hated the prophet because he spoke truth.

This pattern continues today.

A MODERN CLAIM OF DIVINE AUTHORITY

In recent times, statements have been made by political leaders claiming divine appointment and suggesting that their actions are connected to triggering the events of the last days, including Armageddon and the return of the Messiah.

Many believers have repeated these claims and declared such leaders to be **anointed by Jesus**.

This raises a serious spiritual question:

Can a human ruler trigger the return of the Messiah?

Scripture gives the answer.

ELOHIM ALONE CONTROLS THE TIMING OF JUDGMENT

The Bible clearly teaches that the gathering of the nations for the final battle is done by Elohim, not by human rulers.

Elohim Gathers the Nations

Joel 3:2 (KJV)

“I will also gather all nations, and will bring them down into the valley of Jehoshaphat...”

Notice who speaks.

“I will gather all nations.”

It is Elohim.

Elohim Fights the Battle

Zechariah 14:2–3 (KJV)

“For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle...
Then shall YAH go forth, and fight against those nations...”

Elohim gathers the nations.

Elohim fights the battle.

Armageddon is Elohim’s Judgment

Revelation 16:14 (KJV)

“...to gather them to the battle of that great day of Elohim Almighty.”

Armageddon is not a human plan.

It is called:

“The battle of that great day of Elohim Almighty.”

No political leader triggers Armageddon.

WARNING AGAINST TRUSTING RULERS

Scripture repeatedly warns against placing faith in human rulers.

Psalms 146:3 (KJV)

“Put not your trust in princes...”

Jeremiah 17:5 (KJV)

“Cursed be the man that trusteth in man...”

Believers must never treat political leaders as instruments of salvation.

That is idolatry.

THE SIN OF SILENCE

The rebuke is not only against wicked rulers.

The rebuke is against those who see wickedness and remain silent.

The Watchman's Duty

Ezekiel 33:6 (KJV)

“But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet... his blood will I require at the watchman's hand.”

The watchman must warn.

Silence becomes guilt.

James 4:17 (KJV)

“Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.”

Knowing the truth and refusing to speak is sin.

SIGNS OF A CORRUPT SOCIETY

Scripture describes the condition of nations that abandon righteousness.

Isaiah 59:3–4 (KJV)

“For your hands are defiled with blood... none calleth for justice...”

The result is a society where:

- lies replace truth
 - power replaces justice
 - silence protects evil
-

CORRUPT GOVERNMENT

Psalms 94:20 (KJV)

“Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law?”

A government that protects wickedness becomes a throne of iniquity.

Elohim refuses fellowship with such power.

THE REBUKE OF THE SILENT

Isaiah 56:10 (KJV)

“His watchmen are blind... they are all dumb dogs, they cannot bark.”

A watchman who refuses to warn is like a dog that refuses to bark when danger comes.

Useless.

THE GREATEST DANGER — DECEPTION

Matthew 24:4 (KJV)

“Take heed that no man deceive you.”

In the last days deception increases.

Many people follow leaders who confirm their hopes rather than the Word of Elohim.

THE CALL TO REPENTANCE

Elohim always offers repentance before judgment.

Acts 3:19 (KJV)

“Repent ye therefore, and be converted...”

2 Chronicles 7:14 (KJV)

“If my people... turn from their wicked ways...”

Repentance begins with humility.

FINAL WARNING

Isaiah 5:20 (KJV)

“Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil.”

When people excuse wickedness for political reasons, they risk standing against Elohim.

FINAL CHARGE

Elohim alone determines the timing of judgment.

No ruler can claim the authority to trigger the return of Messiah.

Therefore believers must:

- reject false anointing
- reject political idolatry
- reject the sin of silence
- remain faithful to the Word of YAH
